# A Shooting Star Night (2024)

Cette pièce décrit une nuit durant laquelle, seul chez moi, je me suis installé sur une chaise longue dans mon jardin pour regarder la nuit des étoiles filantes en été 2023. Ce ballet d'étoiles, à des milliers de kilomètres de nous, m'a transporté vers un autre monde. Aucun nuage, aucune lumière parasite, simplement moi-même et la Voie lactée me surplombant. Je me suis ensuite assis au piano, vers 3 :00 du matin, et le thème principal de la pièce s'est glissé sous mes doigts.

La pièce s'ouvre sur une atmosphère paisible décrivant la nuit noire, calme et réconfortante qui vous enveloppe comme une couverture. Rien ne se passe, vos yeux cherchent sur cette toile sombre un trait de lumière parmi les étoiles qui peuplent le ciel nocturne. Plus rien n'existe, une profonde sérénité vous envahit avant qu'une première étoile filante ne traverse cette nappe céleste. Vos yeux s'animent de plus en plus tout en restant dans ce moment suspendu, puis une autre étoile, et encore une. Les astres s'activent et offrent un ballet brillant et éclatant. Puis, plus rien, l'obscurité recouvre à nouveau le ciel au-dessus de vous et vous vous sentez absorbé par cette toile noire qui s'étant là-haut. Vous quittez la terre et imaginez les comètes, astéroïdes et autres météorites s'adonnant à une danse chaotique dans l'espace. Les morceaux de roches s'entrechoquent, se brisent, s'effleurent. Certains de ces blocs traversent l'atmosphère et se consument en quelques secondes offrant une chaude lumière l'espace d'un instant. Ce spectacle de la nature vous laisse sans voix alors que les étoiles filantes se multiplient, virevoltant dans tous les sens. L'espace devient de plus en plus vaste et dense, presque oppressant. Soudain, vous basculez votre tête en arrière et fixez le ciel au-dessus de vous. Là se dresse la Voie lactée qui vous surplombe par sa grandeur. Vous distinguez chaque détail d'elle, immense et immobile. Votre regard se perd sur chaque point scintillant qui compose ce monstre cosmique avant de prendre conscience de l'énormité et de la majestuosité de la chose. Contemplant cette merveille de l'univers, vous sentez un bonheur vous envahir et vous fasciner. Vous regagnez cette sérénité et retrouvez les étoiles du début. Paisiblement, vous fermez les yeux, la tête encore là-haut avec les comètes, météores et autres astres.

This piece describes a night when, alone at home, I sat on a deckchair in my garden to watch the night of shooting stars in the summer of 2023. This ballet of stars, thousands of kilometres away, transported me to another world. No clouds, no stray light, just myself and the Milky Way towering over me. I then sat down at the piano, around 3:00 in the morning, and the main theme of the piece slipped through my fingers.

The piece opens with a peaceful atmosphere describing the dark, calm and comforting night that envelops you like a blanket. Nothing happens, your eyes search the dark canvas for a glimmer of light among the stars in the night sky. Nothing exists any more, a deep serenity overcomes you before the first shooting star crosses this celestial sheet. Your eyes become increasingly animated as you remain in this suspended moment, then another star, and another. The stars come alive in a brilliant ballet. Then nothing, darkness once again covers the sky above you, and you feel absorbed by the black canvas above. You leave the earth behind and imagine comets, asteroids and other meteorites doing a chaotic dance in space. Pieces of rock collide, shatter and brush against each other. Some of these blocks pass through the atmosphere and burn up in a matter of seconds, giving off a warm glow for just a moment. This spectacle of nature leaves you speechless as the shooting stars multiply, twirling in all directions. The space becomes increasingly vast and dense, almost oppressive. Suddenly, you tilt your head back and stare up at the sky above you. There stands the Milky Way, towering above you. You can make out every detail of it, immense and motionless. Your gaze wanders over each glittering point that makes up this cosmic monster before realising the enormity and majesty of the whole thing. Contemplating this marvel of the universe, you feel a sense of happiness invade and fascinate you. You regain your serenity and return to the stars of the beginning. Peacefully, you close your eyes, your head still up there with the comets, meteors and other stars.
